#2 – HILTON MILWAUKEE CITY CENTER HOTEL

The Hilton Milwaukee City Center Hotel is located at 509 W. Wisconsin Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53203. Phone number is 414-271-7250.

Hotel rate is \$162/night plus tax. Check-in time is 3:00 pm. Check-out time is 12:00 pm. Early check-in and late check-out may be available – fees may apply.

The Hilton's front desk is on the second floor. A credit card is required at check-in. If using a debit card, an authorization will be taken based on the number of nights in your reservation.

The Hilton has an attached parking garage. The entrance is on 5th Street. The walkway to the hotel is on the 2nd level and there is an elevator with access to each level.

Discounted parking of \$18/night is available for those staying at the hotel. Bring your ticket to the front desk for validation. The parking will be charged to the credit card provided for incidentals.

The Hilton has complimentary Wi-Fi throughout the hotel. You will be given an access code at check-in.

The hotel has been updating the sleeping rooms. All rooms now have a refrigerator and a Keurig coffee machine.

#3 – HOTEL RESTAURANTS

The Hilton has several restaurants for your enjoyment. Here is a brief description of what they serve, where they are located and when they are open. Please note that the Hilton does not have room service.

#4 – MILLER HIGH LIFE THEATER

The Miller High Life Theater (MHLT) is located at 500 W Kilbourn Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53203. The MHLT is 2 blocks from the Hilton.

During the sound check, you will NOT need your badge to enter. You will need to show your All Events badge or single event ticket to enter for the competitions.

No outside food or drink is allowed in the theater except for water. Water must be in a closable container.

Concessions anyone? MHLT Theater concessions will be open during our competitions. Concessions are CASHLESS – you must pay with credit or debit cards. Happy eating and drinking.

#5 – NO SMOKING POLICY

The Hilton and the Miller High Life Theater are smoke-free facilities. The Hilton will charge a cleaning fee if you smoke in your room. Smoking is allowed outside away from any entrance.

#6 – BADGES & TICKETS

Name badges will serve as your All Events Tickets. The badges are needed to enter the competition venue.
