Open Division Contestants – The stage will have a center stage microphone. Please be sure to indicate your emcee work on your cue sheet so the tech crew will know when to have the microphone on for you. As a reminder, our region only offers white lights on stage.

Scooters – A scooter parking is available at the Miller High Life Theater. The area is located in the lobby before the audience entrance. Look for the signs.

We hope none of you will have to withdraw from the contest. If your quartet does have to withdraw prior to convention weekend, please contact Competition Services at the Sweet Adelines office in Tulsa. If your quartet needs to withdraw after arriving in Milwaukee, please notify Shelly Hughes immediately. She can be reached via cell phone at 312-209-4533.

Tickets – Tickets (Badges) are needed to enter the theater. If you leave the theater, you will be required to show your badge to re-enter. Refer to the Schedule of Events for ticket sales and badge pick up times and locations.

2025 Quartet Competition Traffic Pattern – Region #3

Similar to International competitions, we will be utilizing Convention Assistants to move contestants through the pattern.

Check In & Busing

The official pattern will begin in the Hilton. Convention assistants will guide you through each step of the process. A hotel diagram is attached. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes early as space is limited.

At the appropriate time, the convention assistants will escort you to your bus. You will be going outside to load the bus.

To ensure contestants will be able to enter the Miller High Life Theater (MHLT), badges will have to be displayed to board the buses. Please keep badges with each member until you are inside the theater.

Quartets will arrive at the back of the MHLT. A MHLT diagram is attached. Quartets are asked to keep noise levels low as the sound may carry to the stage. After unloading from the bus, quartets will be directed to a holding area. Quartet photos will be taken in the holding area by Read Photography.

Warm-Up Room

At the appropriate time, you will be escorted to warm-up. You will have 10 minutes in warm-up and timing begins when the last member enters the room. No extra time will be allowed for late arrivals or those stopping to use the facilities. Convention staff will give you a 2 minute notice before asking you to move out of the room. Please be ready to move when they return.

Stage

From warm-up, you will be led to the backstage doors. As you leave warm-up, please keep the noise to a bare minimum as sound will carry to the stage.

Stage doors will be opened by convention staff. Convention staff will take your purse bag while you compete. Those on a scooter or in a wheelchair should enter first. Convention staff will direct them on where to park. Parking is a good distance from the stage entrance. You may want to consider having the scooter member unload at the entrance and have a more mobile member drive the scooter to the parking area.

Quartets may enter stage right or center stage. The stage will have a curtain (mid-stage). Convention staff will be on hand to open the curtain for those selecting a center stage entrance. All quartets will exit stage left. You will be lead out of backstage and your purse bag will be returned.

Items of Note

To be fair to all contestants, singing is only allowed in warm-up and on the stage. Your cooperation is appreciated.

If someone has a scooter or wheelchair in the pattern, please note that the Convention Committee, Convention Assistants nor the RMT can assist in moving either a scooter or a wheelchair.


Chairs will be available in all areas of the pattern for those who need to sit.

MAP DOWNTOWN MILWAUKEE




